October 14-16, 2025 (3 days)



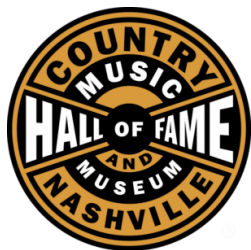
Day 1 – Tuesday, October 14, 2025

We depart this morning for Baxter, TN, and a visit to the **DelMonaco Winery** where we experience a wine tour, tasting and (Included) Lunch. David & Barbara DelMonaco started making wine in their basement and that hobby then evolved into a premier Tennessee winery and vineyard as David decided it was cheaper to build a winery than keep his wife supplied with wine. We invite you to enjoy this showplace winery that is a point of pride for the community and destination place for wine lovers. Our 2-night hotel stay at **Gaylord Opryland Resort** starts with an afternoon at your leisure to explore Gaylord and grab an early (Dutch Treat) Dinner at one of their many restaurant options or you can hop on the shuttle bus to Opryland Mills Shopping Center for additional restaurant choices. Our day culminates at the **Grand Ole Opry**, where we will see a wonderful show, in the fine tradition of the Opry. **Included Meals Today: Lunch**



Day 2 – Wednesday, October 15, 2025

After enjoying an (Included) hotel **Breakfast Buffet at Tennessee Ballroom**, we depart for the **Country Music Hall of Fame**, for a self-guided tour of one of the world's largest museums & research centers dedicated to the preservation & interpretation of American vernacular music. You will have your pick from any of the great restaurants located on "Music Row" in downtown Nashville to enjoy a (Dutch Treat) Lunch. Next on our agenda is a tour of the **Johnny Cash Museum**, which opened in 2013 to honor the life and music of the "Man in Black". This museum is ranked number one music museum in the world by Forbes & National Geographic Traveler. The very special (Included) Dinner tonight will be at **Darfons** where we enjoy a 3-course meal; Soup or Salad, Entrée & Dessert. Entrée choices include: Blackened Prime Rib Slices over Penne Alfredo, Chicken Breast on Fried Cheddar Grits, Gorgonzola Crusted Pork Tenderloin, or Seafood Pasta. After returning to the hotel you can relax with leisure time. **Included Meals Today: Breakfast, Dinner.**



Day 3 – Thursday, October 16, 2025

Enjoy an (Included) hotel **Breakfast Buffet at Tennessee Ballroom** before boarding the bus for travel to visit the **Cookeville History Museum**, where a self-paced tour includes a timeline from the first people to locate in the area to what is happening today and where the front gallery is dedicated to history & traveling exhibits & collection displays. We also visit the **Cookeville Depot Museum**. This building was originally built in 1909, and is now listed on The National Register of Historic Places. The museum houses many Tennessee Central Railway artifacts, as well as an HO scale replica of what Cookeville’s west side looked like in the summer of 1955. The grounds surrounding the museum showcase several train cars for viewing. Next, it’s time for a (Dutch Treat) Lunch at **Crawdaddy’s West Side Grill**, where we can enjoy New Orleans inspired cuisine in an “urban upscale” atmosphere. Our trip is coming to an end as we board the bus to head home to Fairfield Glade. Don’t be sad, there will be more adventures to come. **Included Meals Today: Breakfast**
